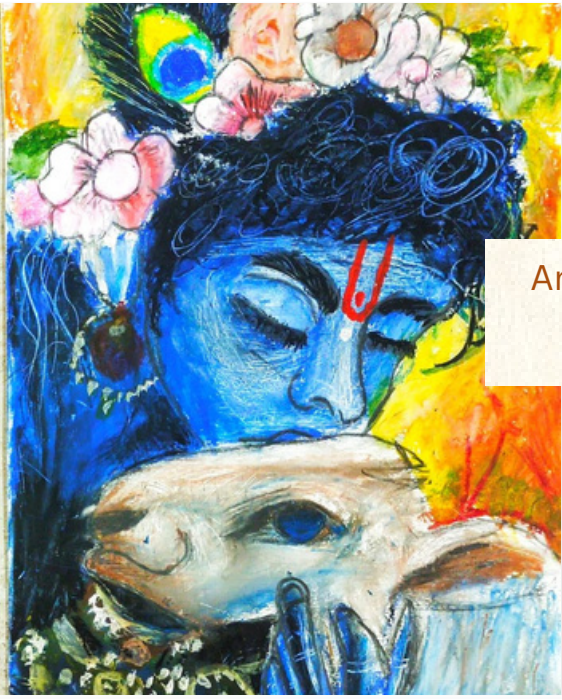


Health Check-up Camp

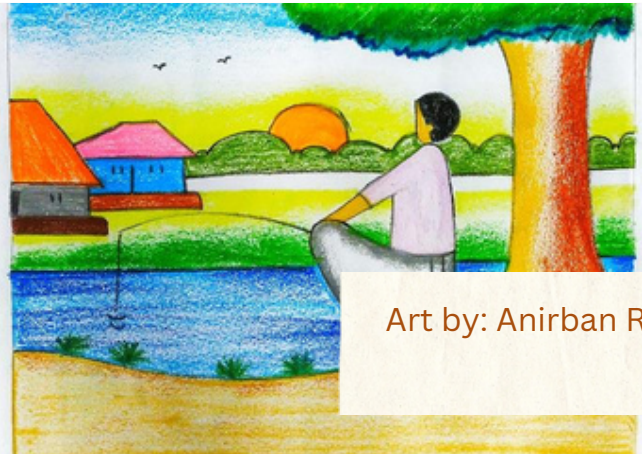

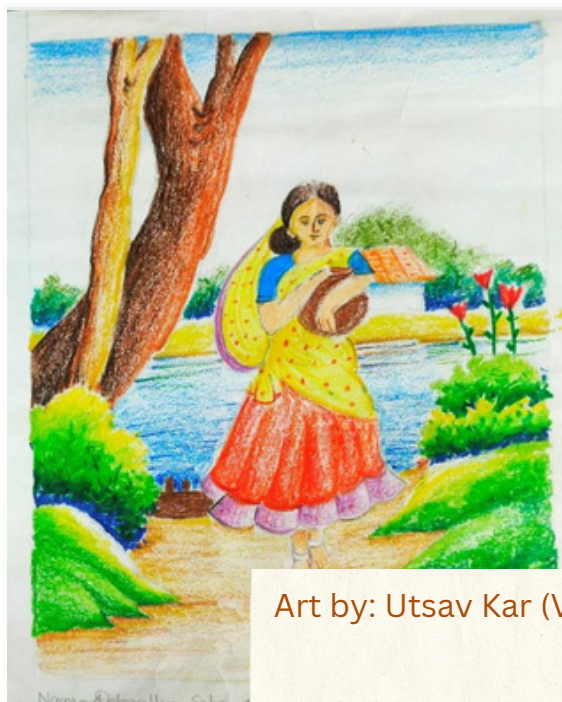
